SUBJECT Early Transit Closure Request – December 2016 Holidays

RECOMMENDATION

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Provide direction to staff on whether Council is willing to direct the transit contractor (SMOOTH, Inc.), to reduce the Guadalupe Flyer route by the last evening loop (6:45 p.m. – 7:50 p.m.) on Christmas and New Year's Eve. This would mirror what is the normal Sunday service schedule on these two Saturdays.

DISCUSSION

In years past, the city's transit contractor has been authorized by the City Administrator to eliminate the last evening flyer loop (6:45-7:50 p.m.) on Christmas and New Year's Eve. These two days are traditionally between 30%-45% slower than normal service days and this year, both days fall on a Saturday the second slowest service day of the week. In addition, the last loop on Saturday is the slowest of the day, averaging 5-7 passengers on a "busy" day and as few as 0-2 passengers on slow days. As has been the practice, SMOOTH would post this early closure on the vehicles well in advance.

Neither the transit operator nor City Administrator has received comments or complaints about previous early closures. In addition, transit staff has been very appreciative of the additional time to spend with family and friends.
