THIS INDENTURE: made this 24th day of June, 1951, by and between Guadalupe Greve No. 100, United Ancient Order of Druids, an unincorporated benevolent association, by ... its trustees, Charles L. Campodonico, George McBane, and P. J. Antognazzini, who constitute the Executive Board of said Grove, the parties of the first part, and the County of Santa Barbara, a body corporate and politic, the party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, and particularly described as follows, to wit:

That portion of Block 3 of the Town of Guadalupe, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, according to the map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Said County, March 8, 1880, described as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of said block 3, and running thence northerly along the westerly line of Guadalupe Street, fifty (50) feet to the point of beginning; thence at a right angle westerly 130 feet; thence at a right angle northerly 100 feet to a point; thence at a right angle easterly 130 feet to the westerly line of Guadalupe Street; thence at a right angle southerly along said westerly line of Guadalupe Street. 100 feet to to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, subject, however, to the additional covenants and conditions herein contained, viz:

- 3. That said building shall be a memorial building for American Veterans, and suitable portions thereof may be used as meeting places by American Veterans, without cost, it being understood that the party of the second part may make any other reasonable use of said building.
- 4. If any of said conditions 1, 2 or 3 are broken, the said real property may be re-purchased by the grantor, its successors or assigns, at the price or sum of Twenty-two Hundred Dollars (\$2200.00).

GRANT DEED

The COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, Grantor, a political subdivision of the State of California, does hereby grant to the City of Guadalupe, Grantee, all that certain real property in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

This conveyance is subject to the use conditions in the Agreement Between The County Of Santa Barbara And The City Of Guadalupe For The Exchange Of Property Tax Revenues, The Conveyance Of Real Property, And The Transfer Of Responsibility For Services Of The Guadalupe Lighting District executed on July 26, 1994, as follows: (1) City of Guadalupe shall take said property AS IS in all respects, including, but not limited to the rights of any and all third parties, and shall assume all obligations of County therein; and (2) City of Guadalupe shall use the building primarily for veterans' activities and incidentally for nonveterans' activities, that City shall provide space in the building for County library services for the benefit of local residents without charge and if ever City, or any successor in interest, shall discontinue such uses, then City shall, at County's option, forfeit to County all right, title and interest in this property.
